

Nesting Box Service

Overview

Nesting boxes are useful tools in the improvement of habitat for bird species such as bluebirds, wood ducks, owls and small mammals like squirrels. In areas where there is a lack of natural cavities such as those provided by dead, standing trees, nesting boxes provide instant shelter of cavity seeking species.



The surveying of boxes during the nesting season can also be a qualifying management activity for 1-D-1 Wildlife Management Valuation.

On the other hand, if nesting boxes are not maintained, they can become a vector of disease and homes for undesirable/invasive species. They will also quickly degrade in quality due to the outdoor elements. Regularly cleaning and repairs are a necessity.

Wildland Systems offers services in the sterilization, repair, surveying, and removal of undesirable species from the nesting boxes on your property. These practices will lead to greater attraction and improved health of desired target species.

During the nesting season, it is recommended that this service be rendered on a monthly basis. Outside of the nesting season, bi-monthly service is suggested in order to continue the suppression of invasive species and maintain high-quality shelter.
